


Toshio Saeki is a Japanese artist and cartoonist, born in 1945, who has made his mark on the art world with his paintings and drawings of erotica, violence, and perversion. As popular in Japan as his fellow artists Takashi Murakami and Aida Makoto he is gaining world wide recognition through gallery and museum shows and through the very fine books such as this elegant volume, ONIKAGE. His art often features men and women in tandem with demons, animals, corpses, and other creatures in various erotic or violent settings. And while his work is controversial, he has been quoted as saying that he enjoys shocking people with his art but that he doesn't live out his fantasies in life!

'Onikage' is a term used for characters in video games and has been defined as 'one of the most sexy 'demon shadows' to ever walk this world and the next'. The pleasure of this book is the detail given to the design of the volume. In this book are twelve images in the 'chinto' style: on the right side of an open book of pages is a black and white drawing of all manner of bizarre sadomasochistic and erotic themes and on the left side is a full page of vellum or glassine that contains the color aspect of the image. By laying the velum over the drawing the print is complete - another way of saying that the reader helps create the final work. Not an artist to give away all his secrets, many of the works in the book are either drawings or reproductions of full images or completed chinto prints. Printmaking, long a favorite art form in Japan, especially the ukiyo-e school, has entered another realm with Toshio Saeki. For those who have not seen his work before this book is an excellent introduction- not only to his class of dignity in sharing the process, but a little hint at how startling his images can be.
